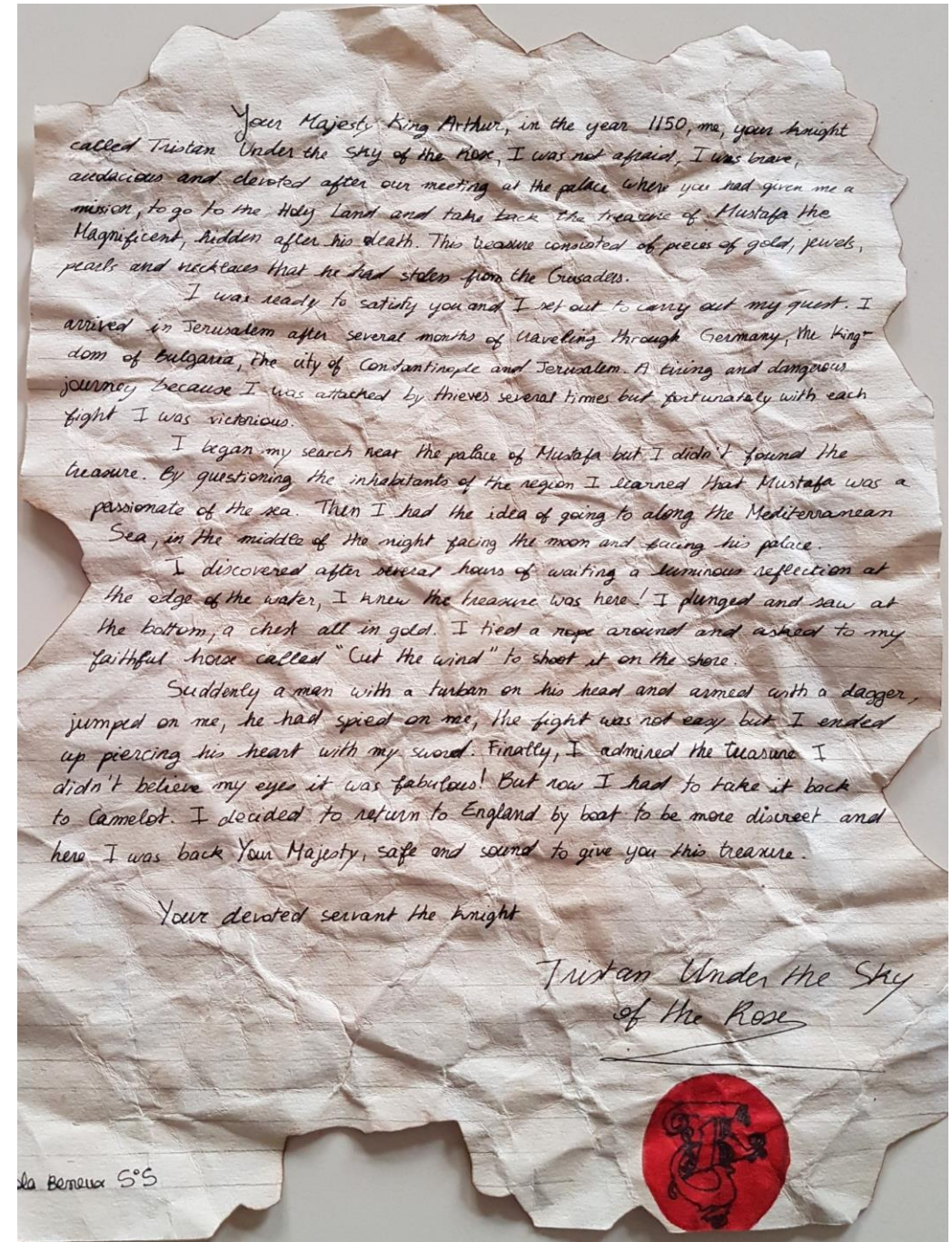
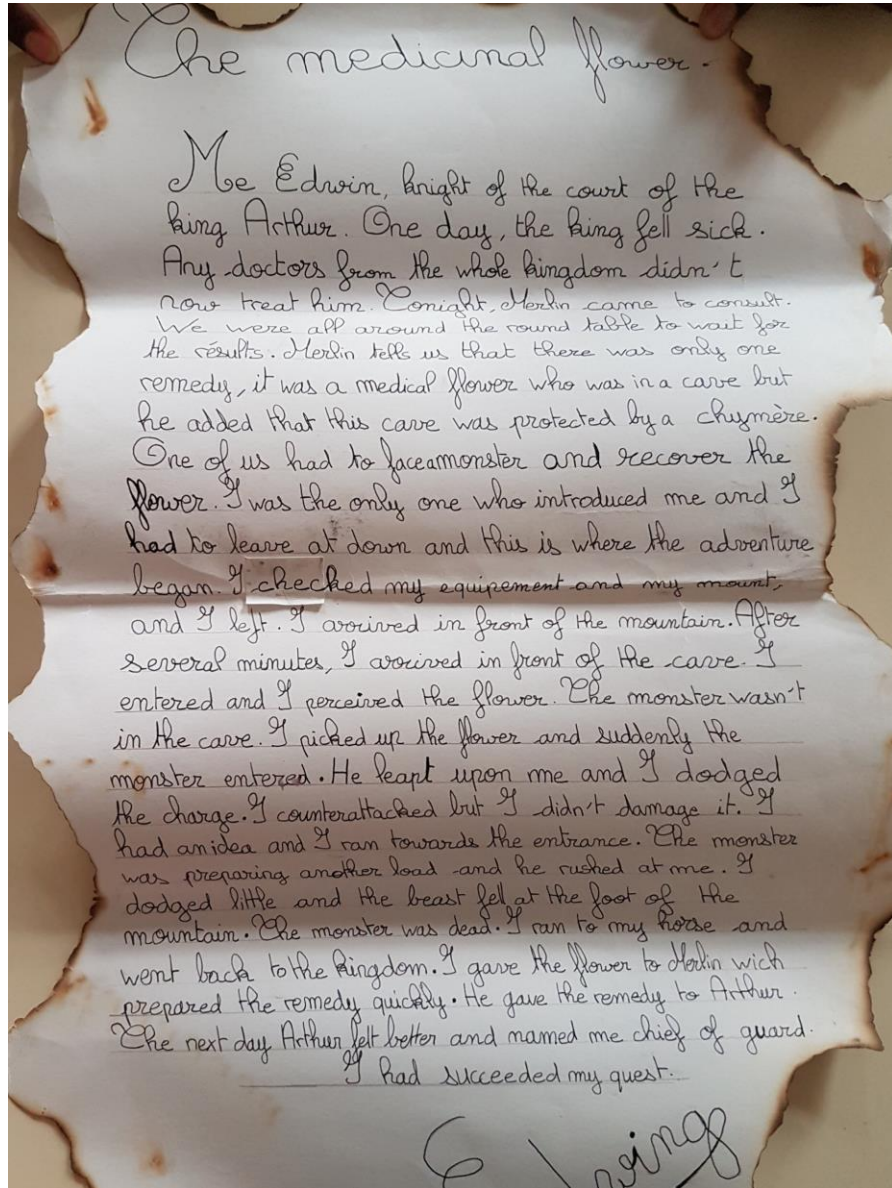


Travail d'écriture après une séquence sur le roi Arthur : faire le récit d'une quête de chevalier



The Brave Knights of Camelot

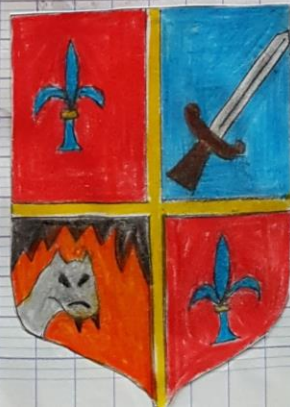
